Quantum GIS

Quantum GIS (QGIS) is a free GIS published under the GNU General Public License.

With QGIS, you can view, create and modify Shapefiles.

In connection with WindPRO, you may especially benefit from some functionalities:

1. Georeferencing of maps including distortion correction (WindPRO doesn't correct distorted maps)
2. Conversion of DXF files to Shapefiles with QGIS' dxf2shp Plugin
3. Saving the current QGIS map view as a georeferenced TIF/TFW map to be used in WindPRO. (*Files* menu | *Save image as*)
4. Checking the coordinate systems of a Shapefile if you are not sure which system it is in.

EMD does not provide support to QGIS. There exist several user community forums for QGIS related questions.
